



This stage of the Camino carries the pilgrim through the heart of the medieval kingdom of Navarra, from the rolling foothills of the Pyrenees Mountains to the vineyards of Spain's famous Rioja region.

### **Day 1 Origin: Roncesvalles**

Arrive in Roncesvalles on your own. Visit the monastery Cloister and museum and attend the evening Pilgrim's Mass in the monastery church before dinner.

- Overnight in Roncesvalles.

### **Day 2 Roncesvalles – Zubiri (22 kms)**

Breakfast. Walk at your own pace through the spectacular green valleys and whitewashed stone villages of northern Navarra, through the Erro Pass to Zubiri.

- Overnight in Zubiri.



### **Day 3 Zubiri – Pamplona (21.5- kms)**

Breakfast. Enter Pamplona today via the medieval Magdalena Bridge and the French Gate in the city's ancient defensive walls. Visit the gothic cathedral, the Plaza del Castillo and the world-famous Estafeta Street where the Running of the Bulls takes place in July each year.

- Overnight in Pamplona

### **Day 4 Pamplona – Puente La Reina (23.5 kms)**

Breakfast. Depart Pamplona across fields of wheat to the Perdón Height with its spectacular views of the valley of Pamplona and the Camino stretching out ahead to Puente la Reina. Don't miss the detour to the charming and enigmatic Romanesque chapel of Eunata before arriving in Puente.

- Overnight in Puente la Reina

### **Day 5 Puente la Reina – Estella (22 kms)**

Breakfast. Cross the 11th Century Queen's Bridge that gives the town its name as you depart Puente la Reina this morning on your way to Estella. You will walk along the ancient Roman road in Cirauqui, past the Río Salado ("Salt River") described in the 12<sup>th</sup> century Pilgrim's Guide, to "Estella la Bella" (Estella the Beautiful), founded by King Sancho in 1090 to attend the growing number of pilgrims journeying to Santiago. Visit the fortified church of San Pedro de la Rúa or the Basilica of the Virgin of Puy and wander the historic city centre this evening.



**Day 6 Estella – Los Arcos (21.8 kms)**

Breakfast. Visit the famous Wine Fountain created for pilgrims by the local Irache winery on your way to Los Arcos this morning. In Los Arcos, view the lovely Baroque altarpiece and the cloister of St. Mary's Church.

- Overnight in Los Arcos

**Day 7 Los Arcos – Logroño (28 kms)**

Breakfast. Make your way to Logroño today. En route, visit the Templar Church in Torres del Río and the Church of St. Mary's in Viana. This evening sample the wine and tapas on offer along Logroño's popular *Calle Laurel*.

- Overnight in Logroño

**Day 8 Logroño – return home**

Breakfast. Depart Logroño for return home or link to Stage 2 and continue.

- Available accommodation along the Camino varies from village to village. Your accommodation may be in one (\*) or two (\*\*) star hotels, \* or \*\* hostels, bed and breakfast style accommodation or similar, monastic guest houses etc. All rooms contracted have private bathrooms.
- The breakfasts included in the price of accommodation are generally simple breakfasts of coffee, tea or hot chocolate; pastries, toast, marmalade, juice, etc.
- Where contracted, dinners are set-price menus that include an appetizer, a meat or fish entrée, dessert, bread, water or wine. After dinner coffee and drinks are not included. Dinners are reserved and served in the restaurants of the contracted hotels wherever possible. In some cases it may be necessary to reserve dinner in nearby restaurants.
- Where contracted, the luggage transport service gives each individual traveler the right to the transport of **one (1)** piece of luggage or no more that **12 kilos (26.5 lbs)**.
